What do you think of when you hear the word "nation?" Most of us envision geopolitical boundaries on a brightly colored map. Understanding this term in a Biblical context will allow us to see God's plan in accomplishing worship as seen in Revelation 5:9.



Four conditions define a nation/people group:

- \_\_\_\_\_ (seed, family line, tribe)
- \_\_\_\_\_ (signs, sounds, speech)
- \_\_\_\_\_ (ordinances, commands, government, rules)
- \_\_\_\_\_ (territory, border)



Though all people groups/nations are different and unique, they each have unifying characteristics (like communication, dependence upon each other, and worship) which draw them together. However, even among nations and

families, each has distinct likes and dislikes. We might say that this diversity is a great thing, but the more important fact is that diversity is a God thing.

The diversity of the nations is God's pleasure. It is intentional and eternal, and it magnifies the glory of God. United diversity focuses all praise on Him. God's fame increases in proportion to the diversity of the people who recognize His beauty. The diversity of the people groups who give up their false gods to follow the true God makes God's greatness more visible.
